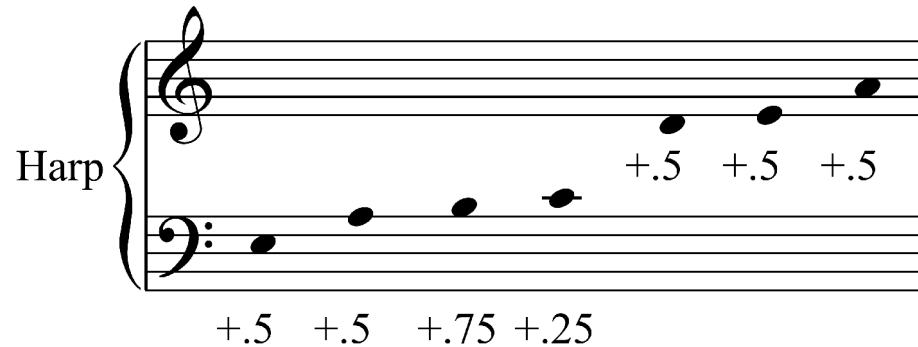
PERFORMANCE NOTES



deviation in semitones: +1. +.75 +.50 +.25 .0 -.25 -.50 -.75 -1.

THE NUMBER OF FLAT AND SHARP SIGNS HAS BEEN EXPANDED TO NOTATE 4 POSSIBLE DEGREES OF FLAT AND 4 POSSIBLE DEGREES OF SHARP (EIGHTH-TONES).

A FEW OF THE HARP'S STRINGS NEED TO BE RETUNED TO APPROXIMATE THESE TUNINGS (USE A TUNER IF YOU HAVE ONE).



ALL INDICATED STRINGS MUST BE TUNED SHARP BY THE SPECIFIED AMOUNT.

A TUNING KEY IS USED TO VERY SLIGHTLY BEND VARIOUS PITCHES IN THE PIECE. THE KEY SHOULDN'T NEED TO BEND THE STRING MORE THAN A CENTIMETER OR SO. IT IS ALSO PERFECTLY ACCEPTABLE TO REMOVE THE KEY FROM THE STRING BEFORE IT HAS STOPPED RINGING.

THE VIOLA MUST APPROXIMATE THE EIGHTH-TONE DEVISIONS DURING THE PERFORMANCE. SHE MAY WISH TO MARK THE STRING. MORE IMPORTANT THAN SOUNDING THE EIGHTH-TONE ACCURATELY IS TO MAKE THE EIGHTH-TONE RELATIVE IN DISTANCE FROM WHATEVER PITCH IS BEFORE AND AFTER IT. TO ASSIST THIS, AN INDICATION OF THE AMOUNT OF DEVIATION IS ALWAYS SHOWN ABOVE ANY EIGHTH-TONE.

THE LENGTHS OF PHRASES ARE DETERMINED BY THE PERFORMERS. PHRASES THAT ARE CONNECTED IN BOTH PARTS BY A DOTTED LINE OCCUR SLIGHTLY AFTER ONE ANOTHER.
